Location: Cumnock, Ayrshire. Occasional travel to sites across the UK

Rate of pay: £12.50/hr

This is a hands-on role constructing timber-framed modular homes within a factory environment. You will support the lead joiner in completion of the structure and internal finishes- measuring, cutting and ensuring a free flow of materials and tools whilst keeping the work bay safe and tidy at all times.

A Joiner's Mate will require the following:

- Min. 5 years' experience working in a construction or manufacturing environment
- Ability to read and interpret architectural and engineering drawings
- Be self-motivated and with a positive attitude
- Excellent communication skills both verbal and written
- Minimum National 4 level maths or equivalent
- To be punctual and reliable

- Ensuring all tools are properly maintained, calibrated and charged
