The Architect will require the following:

- Masters of Architecture or equivalent
- RIBA/RIAS chartered
- Min. 5 years' experience of new build, low rise residential design and timber kit

The Architect will ideally have the following:

- Experience of residential development projects up to £20m
- Experience of leading the statutory approvals process
- Experience leading a design team and being the main point of contact for clients
- Experience of social housing
- A valid CSCS card
- A full UK driver's license and own transport

Reporting to the Managing Director, the role will involve:

- Assisting in the preparation of tender submissions
- Planning job timescales and assess the levels of risk on a project.
- Attend relevant client meetings and site visits



- Design house types which meet potential client's design brief as well as modular design parameters
- Design indicative site layouts for inclusion in tenders, contract negotiations and feasibility appraisals
